If traveling from SF, LA or NYC, suggest taking TACA Airlines red-eye flights for best flight times and schedule.

DAY 1: 01/30 (Saturday) – Pick up group at San Jose Airport or nearby hotels at 10:30 am / Transfer to San Isidro in Private Shuttle Bus (3 hour drive) / Stop for lunch at La Georgina Restaurant (overlooking Cerro de La Muerte) / Transfer in 4x4 SUVs to Pueblo Nuevo Eco-Village/Buenaventura (1 hour drive) / Check in / Group Dinner / Stay 1st night in Buenaventura's Pueblo Nuevo Eco-Village

DAY 2: 02/01 (Sunday) – Breakfast at Tres Semillas / Orientation Day of Buenaventura, Tres Semillas Organic Farm and Pueblo Nuevo Eco-Village / Stay 2nd night in Buenaventura's Pueblo Nuevo Eco-Village

DAY 3: 01/18 (Monday) – Real Estate Discovery Day / Visit & Survey River-front lots for sale in the area / Spend afternoon hanging out at the river / Stay 3rd night in Buenaventura's Pueblo Nuevo Eco-Village

If you have United Miles, TACA is affiliated with United, so you might be able to use your miles for these flight dates. Please check with United directly).

* All meals & drinks during Optional Pacific Coast excursion (~\$100-\$150)

* Any Additional Tours and Activities in Manuel Antonio (~\$70-\$100)

Buenaventura is an Eco-Adventure Mountain Lodge, Rainforest Rejuvenation Retreat & Wellness Center, and Nature Park & Wildlife Refuge Reserve located in the Rio Division Valley of Costa Rica.

Buenaventura welcomes groups, couples, families and individuals seeking a remote, private and isolated destination for eco-adventure activities, rainforest retreats, and to experience Costa Rica's local culture & rural county living.

Nourish yourself with home-grown organic meals, fresh spring water, solitude, serenity and the comforts for ultimate relaxation and rejuvenation.

With almost a mile of riverfront, Buenaventura's 180 acres of mountainous rainforest property are located along the north side of Rio Division, with 40% of the property within the southern border of the Los Santos Forest Reserve, an area north of Buenaventura with over 300,000 acres of protected primary and secondary Tropical Cloud Forests and Humid Rain Forests and where many endangered animals (like Jaguars, Tapirs, Sloths, etc.) and plant species live on the western valleys and foothills of the Talamanca Corridor.

Buenaventura currently offers lodging in Buenaventura's "Pueblo Nuevo River-side Eco-Village" located in an isolated and remote valley, between dense rainforest mountains in the valley of River Division.

Pueblo Nuevo is set between the river and a back-country dirt road that dead-ends 2 miles downriver in the town of El Brujo (The Wizard), and leads back out to the city of San Isidro about a 1.5 hour drive away.
