

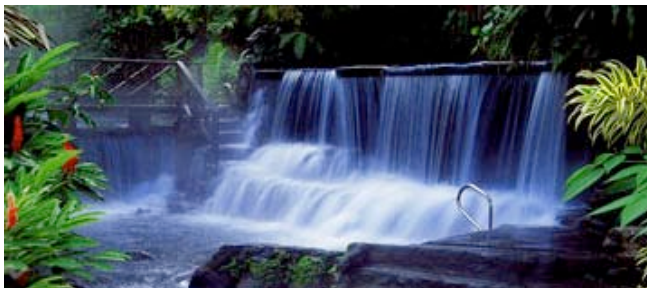
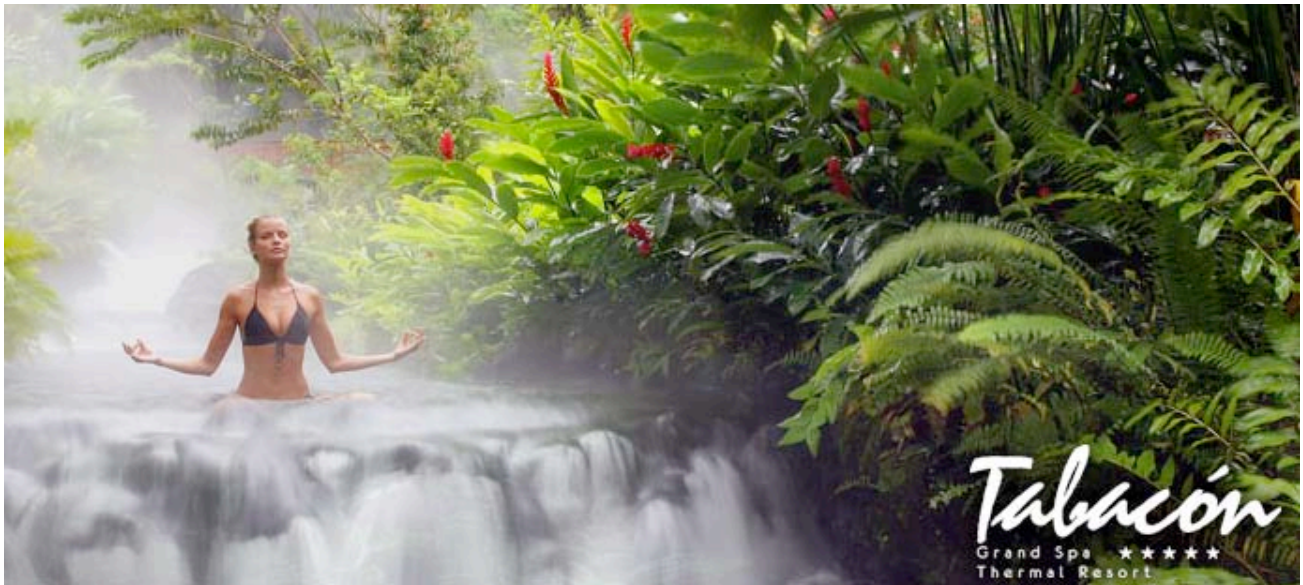
TOURS SUMMARY

Byron & Melissa - Costa Rica Honeymoon Trip

The following Activities have been paid in advance and scheduled in your Itinerary.

In Arenal:

Arenal Volcano Hiking Tour & Tabacon Hot Springs



TOUR DATE: Wednesday, May 25th 2011

Pick up at hotel: 3:05 PM (they will pick you up at your hotel)

Drop off at hotel: ~10 PM

PAYMENT STATUS: TOUR PAID IN ADVANCE (includes transfer to/from hotel)

Suggested tip for Guide: \$10

WHAT TO BRING: Sturdy close-toed shoes, shorts and short sleeve shirt, camera with a ziplock bag, insect repellent, binoculars and rain shell, swim suit, flip flops, change of warm clothes after hot springs for dinner.

La Fortuna Waterfall & Horseback Tour



TOUR DATE: Thursday, May 26th

Pick up at hotel: 8:20 AM (they will pick you up at your hotel)

Drop off at hotel: ~ 2:00 PM

PAYMENT STATUS: TOUR PAID IN ADVANCE (includes transfer to/from hotel)

Suggested tip for Guide: \$10

WHAT TO BRING: Sturdy close-toed shoes, long-sleeve pants and light-weight long sleeve shirt (for horseback riding), bathing suit underneath your clothes, camera with a ziplock bag, insect repellent, camelback with water, and light rain shell (if it looks like its going to rain).

About the tour:

The length of the tour is approximately four hours; from La Fortuna we have to go 5 ½ kilometers to the southeast. We spend 1 ½ hours to get to the rest site of the horses.

A beautiful example of the Costa Rican country site will be found along the way, cattle farms and agriculture, also the chance to see some birds as oropendolas and tucans. After that you have to walk five hundred meters into the forest to get to the waterfall, which is 70 meters high.

At the base of the waterfall there is a “natural pool” where we can swim in the fresh water of La Fortuna river for about one hour.

WHAT TO BRING: Sturdy close-toed shoes, pants, camera with ziplock bag, insect repellent, binoculars and rain shell.



Package Includes:

Canopy Tour: Traverse through cables and zip lines through the Cloud Forest. The Canopy Tour consists of 15 cables and 18 platforms and takes approximately 2.5 or 3 hours. In this tour visitors will be zipped through each of the cables while attached to a top safety harness and using the best climbing gear available. It is an adventurous tour that elevates adrenaline to the maximum while keeping the safety level as the main goal.

Treetop Walkways: Simply the best way to observe the Cloud Forest Canopy with the advantage of being able to take your time to observe each of the forest levels. This tour may be taken either guided or self guided. Different fees apply for guided and non-guided tours. The tour consist on a 1.9 mile trail that cruises through the forest, along the trails you will find each of the eight different bridges that compose this bridge system. The lengths and heights of these bridges vary between 170 feet and 560 feet in length and heights between 40 feet and 260 feet. The tour takes between 1.5 and 2 hours.

Butterfly Garden: One of the world's largest live butterfly exhibitions with more than 50 different species of butterflies from all over Costa Rica. In this tour a guide will join you and introduce you to the world of butterflies and all its wonders. This guided tour takes between 45 minutes and 1 hour.

Selvatura Education Center: Learn all there is to see inside the cloud forest and see some of the stuff you might have missed. You'll be able to enjoy of the world largest private insect collection, property of world famous entomologist Dr. Richard Whitten. You will also be able to observe exclusive footage of the cloud forest wonders inside the center's cinematic auditorium. Special tours are available for student groups. This tour lasts about 1 hour.

Hummingbird Garden: Visitors will be able to observe more than 14 different species of hummingbirds from the cloud forest. A treat for photography lovers and a spectacular air show for anyone who loves nature. No time limit for this tour.

In Manuel Antonio:

Savegre River Rafting Tour

WHAT TO BRING: Tennis or teva-style shoes that you don't mind getting wet, bathing suit, camera with ziplock waterproof bag, sun block, rain shell and a complete change of warm, dry clothes to change into after rafting.
